**All participants, by their participation in the tournament, and by signing above, are subject to a Polygraph Test. Any participant that fails the Polygraph Test will be disqualified immediately.**

## **“ CAMP MACK OPEN “ - - - RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. All boats must carry equipment as required by U.S. Coast Guard Regulations.
2. Life jackets must be worn when gas motor is in gear.
3. Kill switch will be in operating condition and affixed to drivers life jacket.
4. Take off will be determined by registration received.
5. **FIVE (5) FISH LIMIT.** Minimum of 14 inches measured on a “Golden Rule” measuring board, mouth closed, tail fanned or straight, which ever measures on the Golden Rule. Any short fish brought to scale will result in an automatic loss of Big Bass Weight and the Short Fish Weight. **At no time shall any competing team have in their possession more than the tournament limit of five (5) fish. Culling fish must be done immediately upon catching the sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) fish. Mangled, mashed, mauled or otherwise altered fish will be grounds for immediate disqualification.**
6. **DEAD FISH** -- Every dead fish will result in one-quarter pound (.25) penalty from total weight.
7. **TIES:** Ties that occur in the regular monthly tournaments will be settled by combining the prize money for the two places and splitting it equally. Ties that occur in the Classic will be determined by the most weight for the year. If there is a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> Place in the Classic, there will be a one-hour Fish-Off.
8. No fishing within fifty (50) yards of a boat at legal anchor, trolling motor up, and anchor down. No trolling allowed.
9. Artificial bait only.
10. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be in boat during tournament.
11. All boats will be inspected before take off.
12. Any competitor at the age of sixteen (16) and under must have parents signed consent to fish this event or be accompanied by an adult.
13. Take off at safe light. Running lights must be working or you will have to wait till sun is up. Please have light in boat and turned on for boat inspection.
14. **LATE PENALTY:** Teams will be checked in at a designated place (to be announced before take-off). Any team late for check in by their prescribed time will lose one (1) pound per minute, after ten minutes automatically disqualified.
15. **BREAK DOWN:** If you break down and cannot contact another tournament boat and cannot make your check in time, you will be disqualified. If you contact another tournament boat, one partner can transport the team’s fish to weigh-in.
16. **SPORTSMANSHIP:** Courtesy, safety and conservations are expected from each participant. This includes cooperation with all state, county and local laws and officials if approached while fishing.
17. No rafting up of boats or transfers between boats except as described in number 15 above.
18. Boats to remain “Under Way” until berthing for weigh-in. IE: Must not land anywhere.
19. Do not remove your boat from the water until after your fish have been weighed in, after that you may load your boat and park in the parking lot. Do not bring your boat to the weigh-in site as we will be limited on space.
20. **PROTESTS:** All protests shall be brought to the attention of the Tournament Director. **All protests must be in writing and turned in to the Tournament Director no later than thirty (30) minutes after start of official weigh-in. If not, the protest will be considered invalid.** The decision of the Tournament Director and his/her staff is final.
21. **POLYGRAPH TESTS:** All participants, by their participation in the tournament and their signing of the entry form, are subject to a Polygraph Test. **Any participant that fails the Polygraph Test will be disqualified immediately.**
22. Weigh-ins will be at 2:00 p.m. No boat will be weighed in before scheduled times.
23. Tiger Creek and Lake Tiger are **OFF LIMITS.**
24. **Starts Saturday, January 7, 2012 and then the first Saturday of each month through October, 2012. The Classic will be Saturday, November 3 and Sunday, November 4, 2012.**
25. **To Qualify for the Classic you must pay for or fish a minimum of seven (7) events.**
